Commencement Ceremony Information and Guidelines

The Class of 2020 Graduation Ceremony will be held Thursday, May 21st @ 7pm at Parrish Stadium (football field). If it rains, the ceremony we will be postponed to Friday, May 22nd,

1. Graduation Guidelines

- There are guidelines that must be followed in order to ensure the safety of all students, faculty, and guests. In compliance with the ADPH and the Governor Ivey's "Safer at Home" Order:
 - The Commencement Ceremony must be held in a facility that will allow a distance of 6ft between families
Family members of the same household may sit together without regard to the social distancing requirement
Social distancing is to be observed before, during, and after the ceremony while on school campus.
 - In order to be compliant with these guidelines outlined by the ADPH, each graduate will receive eight tickets for their guests. We will take tickets up at the entrance to the football field. No one can come in without a ticket and every one of all ages who attends must have a ticket.
 - We will require individuals who attend to follow social distancing and CDC guidelines and those who do not comply will be asked to leave the ceremony:
- All individuals and especially vulnerable persons, are encouraged to exercise personal responsibility by doing the following:
 - If you have been exposed to any individual with the COVID-19 virus or are not feeling well you should not attend the ceremony.
 - If you have a fever or a consistent cough, you should not attend the ceremony
 - If you have preexisting healthy, conditions you should not attend the ceremony.
 - You will be required to sit with your family only and social distance 6 feet from others
- If you do not have a graduate as an immediate family member, please view the ceremony via Facebook Live and do not attend the live ceremony.
- You should not hug, shake hands, or touch other individuals while on the PCHS campus.
- If you have to cough, cough in your elbow and refrain from touching your face.

2. Graduation Attire:

- Boys will wear khaki or dark colored dress pants, tie, and dress shoes. No tennis shoes or blue jeans are allowed.
- Girls will wear dresses under their gowns that should be no longer than their gown. Color does not matter. Girls should wear sandals or flats as the ceremony will be held on the football field.
- Graduation caps CANNOT BE DECORATED ON TOP in any way. No sequins, tape, sayings, stickers, etc. will be allowed.

3. Cap and Gown Pictures:

- Pictures will be made at 5pm the day of graduation. An envelope to order these pictures will be in your senior packet. On the day of cap and gown pictures, wear anything you would wear during the ceremony.

4. Graduation Practice: Thursday, May 21st at 10 A.M. in the high school gym.

5. Prom and Senior Trip Refunds: Refunds will be given prior to graduation.

6. Outstanding Fees and Outstanding Balances:

- Seniors MUST have all fees and outstanding balances paid by this week.

7. Make-Up and Over Due Work

- Any senior that has work they need to get turned it need to turn it in by the end of this week.
